Fees are non-refundable unless your spot is filled from a wait list.

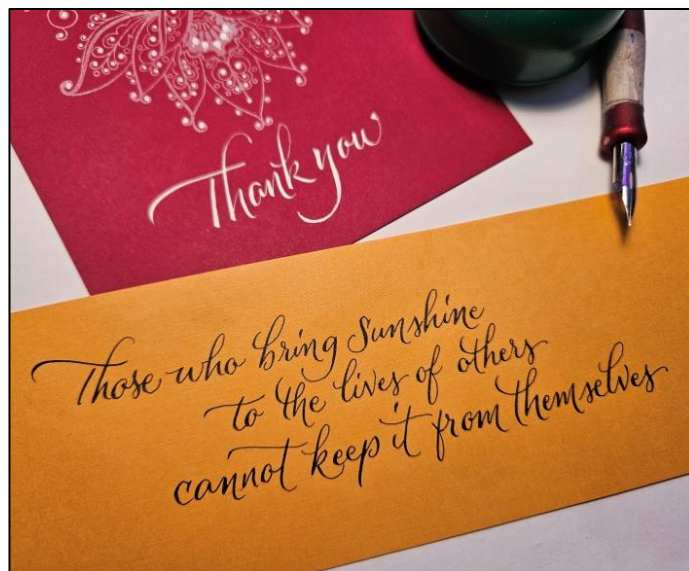
Class size is limited to 14 students.
