Members were asked to use their ingenuity to create any kind of piece which makes use of folds or pleats or shaped paper.

The Ewan Clayton workshop on Bon Shahn silowed me to come up with this quirky and playful leyout on paper. The design was traced onto a piece of state measuring 1 x 7 x 26 inches The latters were then hand carried using a hammer and chisel. After canning, I used bright 1 Shot eneme! paints to finish the letters, trying to capture the colours of flowers. Eventually, this will be mounted on a large hand-corved sandstone boulder in a garden
