Repetition and patterns are a breeze with eraser stamps. Plain white vinvl erasers were carved with the humble X-acto knife, inexpensive supplies. THE ST. IOHN'S BIBLE AT ST. MARY'S LINIVERSITY

n April St. Mary's University in Calgary was the destination for a BVCG field trip. St. Mary's University is home to Western Canada's only full-sized fine art reproduction of The Saint John's Bible. This is the first handwritten and illuminated Bible in more than 500 years. The Bible was commissioned in 1998 by the Benedictine monks of Saint John's Abbey and University in Minnesota, Donald Jackson (scribe to Queen Elizabeth) and a team of scribes. artists and craftspeople used quills, natural handmade inks, hand-ground pigments and gold leaf on vellum. St. Mary's makes the volumes accessible and Barb Fuller made arrangements for BVCG members and guests to spend about two hours with two of the volumes with volunteers from the University giving us further insight.
