4 x 6 inches

These are drawn letters, intertwined and painted with various shades of red gouache with a darker tone where the letter goes under the one on top. Afterwards the letters were outlined with a black glaze pen.

VOGI GRUNWALD "Flowers Say Hello" 5 x 7 inches

The calligraphy roses were scanned and resized from my "Early One Morning" piece onto white cardstock. I cut them out using my Silhouette Cameo electronic cutter. I sponged some Distress red ink all over, and then quilled and shaped the roses.

The quote was lettered with a 3.8mm Pentel Parallel pen using Sumi ink on white cardstock. I added some coloured pencil shading in the "o's". The oval was cut with a Spellbinder's oval die set and adhered to a red textured card base. I die cut the leaves from an alcohol decorated paper.
